DESCRIPTION

A limited quantity of new and refurbished 17" Attachable TVs were identified as exhibiting a problem, whereby TV channels that were scanned and stored within the product, are then dropped after power cycling. This only affects the models listed below. The vendor has identified the problem as a missed step in the TV configuration, and the solution is known.

This Service Bulletin will describe how to rectify this problem.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Obtain the TV Factory Menu access code from John Hiestand (i.e. this code is controlled).
- 2. Use the IR Remote and press the code keys to get to the TV Factory Menu. This screen will appear.





3. Navigate with the arrow down/up buttons on the IR Remote to highlight "INIT FLASH" on this menu.



- 4. Press "Enter" to execute the "Do" function for this INIT FLASH choice.
- 5. TV will power off automatically after completing the "Do" function.
- 6. Power on TV. Upgrade is complete.
- 7. Rescan channels. They will now remain after a TV power cycle.
