HOW TO FILL THE AUTOMATIC WAXING SYSTEM — LIFESTRIDE* 9500/9100

Tools Required: 5/32" Hex key wrench

NOTE: CHECK EXPIRATION DATE ON WAX CONTAINER BOX BEFORE PROCEEDING. IF EXPIRATION DATE IS EXCEEDED RETURN THE UNOPENED CONTAINER TO LIFE FITNESS PRODUCT SUPPORT FOR REPLACEMENT.

Step 1 (See Figure 2)

For the TR-9500, use a 5/32" hex key wrench to remove the SCREWS (3) from the *right* FRONT FRAME CAP. Remove the FRONT BELT GUARD and set aside. For the TR-9100, use a 5/32" hex key wrench to remove the SCREWS (2) from the *left* REAR FRAME CAP and set aside.


Step 2 (See Figure 2)

Locate the BRASS VALVE and HOSE within the machine, gently pull it out for easier access.

Step 3 (See Figure 1)

Pull up on the wax bag cap, remove the cap and screw on the FILLING HOSE.

CAUTION: WAX IS IN A LIQUID STATE. DO NOT TILT THE BOX BEFORE CHECKING THE FILLING HOSE CAP AND CLAMP. MAKE CERTAIN THE HOSE CLAMP IS "PINCHING" THE HOSE PREVENTING THE WAX FROM ESCAPING.

Step 4 (See Figure 2)

With the FILLING HOSE CAP and CLAMP securely in place, position the WAX BOX upside down resting it on the HANDLEBAR and DISPLAY CONSOLE. Route the FILLING HOSE between the HANDLEBAR and DISPLAY CONSOLE to the BRASS VALVE inside the machine.

Step 5 (See Figure 2)

Slip the FILLING HOSE over the barbed HOSE FITTING on the BRASS VALVE, allowing the HOSE to fill completely with wax. Turn the VALVE HANDLE to the full "OPEN" position then release the CLAMP on the FILLING HOSE. The wax will flow freely out of the box into the CONTAINER.

This procedure takes approximately 8 minutes for all 5 quarts of wax to transfer into the WAX

Step 6 (See Figure 2)

When air bubbles appear in the FILLING HOSE the transfer is completed. Check bottle to ensure it is emptied then press down on the FILLING HOSE CLAMP to stop the wax flow, and turn the BRASS VALVE HANDLE to the fully "CLOSED" position.

Step 7

Disengage the FILLING HOSE and discard the WAX BOX. CAUTION: WAX SOLUTION BETWEEN THE CLAMP AND VALVE WILL DRAIN OUT. The filling procedure is now completed. Replace the BRASS VALVE in the treadmill. Reinstall the FRONT BELT GUARD and FRONT FRAME CAP on the TR9500 or the REAR FRAME CAP on the TR9100. The machine is now fully operational. The solution will last approximately 1 year.
