



Power Crunch Cover Selection

Over the years we have made many design improvements to our Power Crunch ab machines. This has resulted in changes to the black plastic covers that were used in production of that machine. This guide is designed to help you order the correct cover for your machine.

Older PC1000 covers



Illustration 1: Early PC1000 pic1

This cover is one of the older ones we used. Note the square design and round hole for the hand-grip. A variation of this cover without the hand-grip hole and with mounting flanges along both sides was also used. Please note those exceptions if you need that cover.



Illustration 2: Early PC1000 pic2

In this view the hole for the shaft collar is visible, also the mounting flange on the far side of the cover.



Illustration 3: Newer PC1200/2000 cover

Newer version, note the rounded corners, also the mounting flange is on the opposite side.

Also note the closed ends. Ends on the early cover are open.



Illustration 5: Current design pic1

More or less what we use today. Design is slimmer, all mounting fasteners are on top of the cover.
