

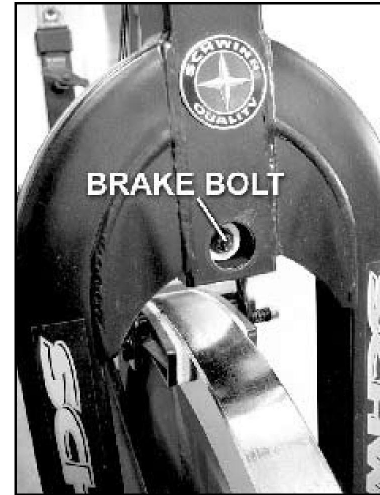
Basic Troubleshooting

Problem: Brake Pads Off Center

Solution:

- A. Use a 10mm wrench to loosen the nylon nut on the front of the bike.
- B. Adjust the brake assembly until the brake pads are evenly spaced from the flywheel.
- C. Tighten the nylon nut using moderate torque.

Problem: Chain is too Loose

Solution:

- A. Use a 15mm wrench or socket to loosen each axle nut of the flywheel.
- B. Use a 10mm wrench and turn each chain tensioner bolt 1/4 turn to the right.
- C. Get on the bike and check for any play in the chain by rocking back and forth on the pedals.
- D. Tighten the axle nuts on the flywheel once the pedals and the flywheel are moving as one.

NOTE: Make sure that the flywheel aligns with the frame.
