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SM3 Change List

SM3 (140001)

This document outlines the major mechanical changes that have been made to the SM3 since release.

- Central drive shaft change – Starting with 140001DAY14330001
 - Redesign (723-0274-KT) replaced the original central drive shaft with a collar and keyway design to increase strength in piece. (Fig. 1)

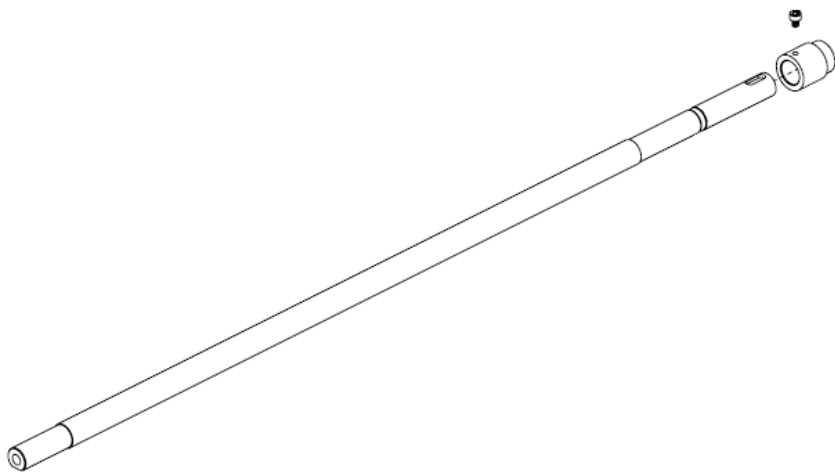

- Lower sprocket assembly change – Starting with 140001DAY14330001
 - Redesign (723-0278-KT) lower sprocket assembly with a keyway design to increase strength in piece (Fig. 2)

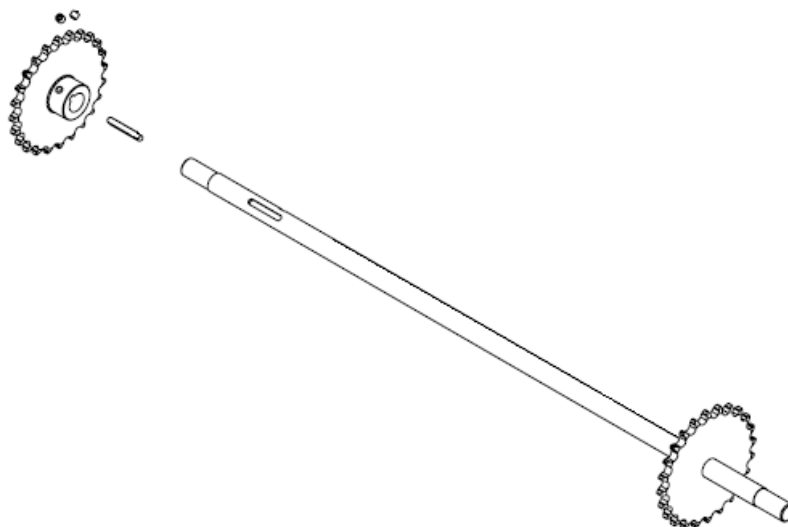

- Upper sprocket assembly change – Starting with 140001DAY14330001
 - Redesign (723-0279-KT) upper sprocket assembly with a keyway design to increase strength in piece (Fig. 3)

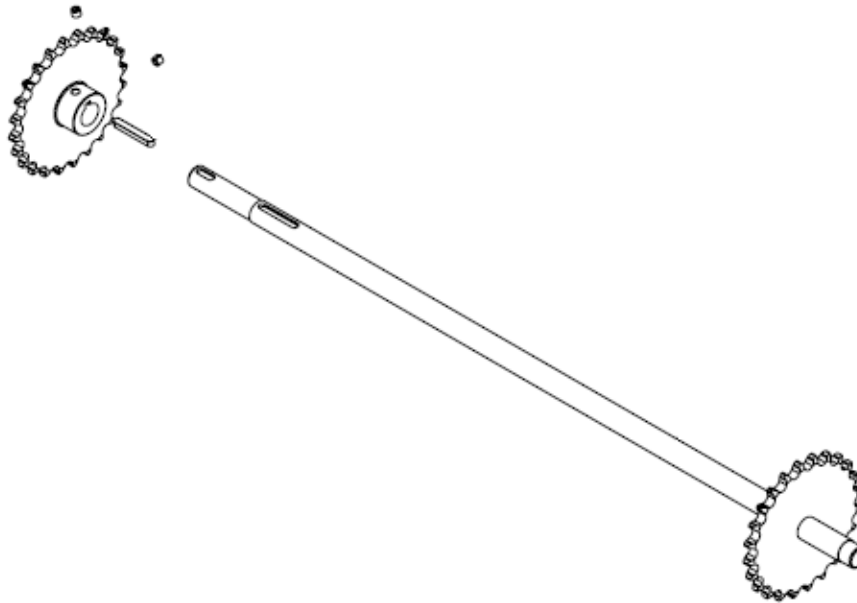

- Frame and idler assembly change – Starting with 140001DAY14490001
 - Redesign frame to accommodate new idler (723-0281) design to reduce chance of belt slippage and increase consistency in step rate (Fig. 4) **Please note that this is not a retrograde fitting that can be applied to SM3s prior to serial number 140001DAY14490001.**

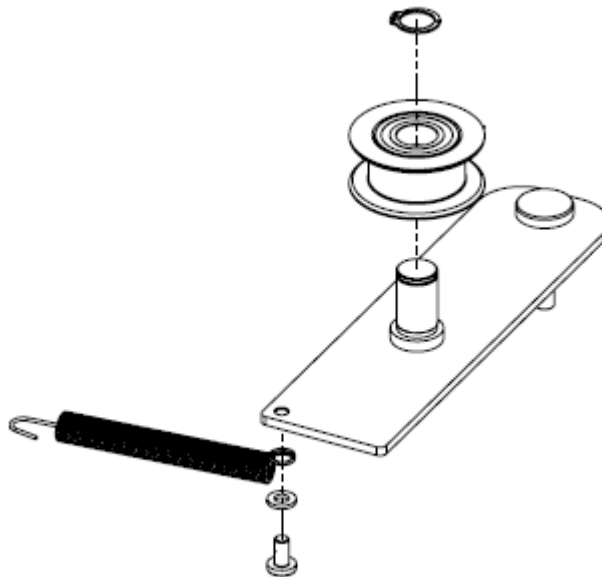
